Rakan-rakan sekerja Nexus telah menyahut seruan Kementerian Kesihatan untuk menyumbang khidmat kesukarelawan dalam usaha menangani pandemik Covid-19 di negara ini. 9 rakan sekerja telah mendaftar dan empat daripada mereka telah dipanggil untuk bertugas bermula minggu lepas. Mereka telah ditugaskan di Pusat Vaksinasi, Berakas. Mereka menyertai beribu-ribu sukarelawan lain yang telah menyahut cabaran membantu barisan hadapan Kementerian Kesihatan dengan menjalankan tugas-tugas berisiko rendah seperti perkhidmatan pentadbiran dan sekretariat, pusat pengasingan di hotel, pusat pengedaran makanan, perkhidmatan penghantaran makanan kepada mereka yang menjalani Perintah Kuarantin, menguruskan sistem dan pangkalan data, pengesanan kontak, mentadbir pusat-pusat vaksin serta logistik.



*Nexus associates have responded to the call by the Ministry of Health to provide voluntary service in its current efforts to manage the Covid-19 pandemic in the country. 9 associates have registered and four of them have been called up for duty last week. They have since been assigned to the Vaccination Centre in Berakas. They are joining thousands of other volunteers who have stepped up to the challenge in support of the MOH frontliners by carrying out mainly low-risk tasks such as manning the administration and secretariat services, the isolation centres at hotels, food distribution centres, food delivery services to people on Quarantine Order, managing the system and database, contact tracing, administering the vaccination centres as well as logistics.*



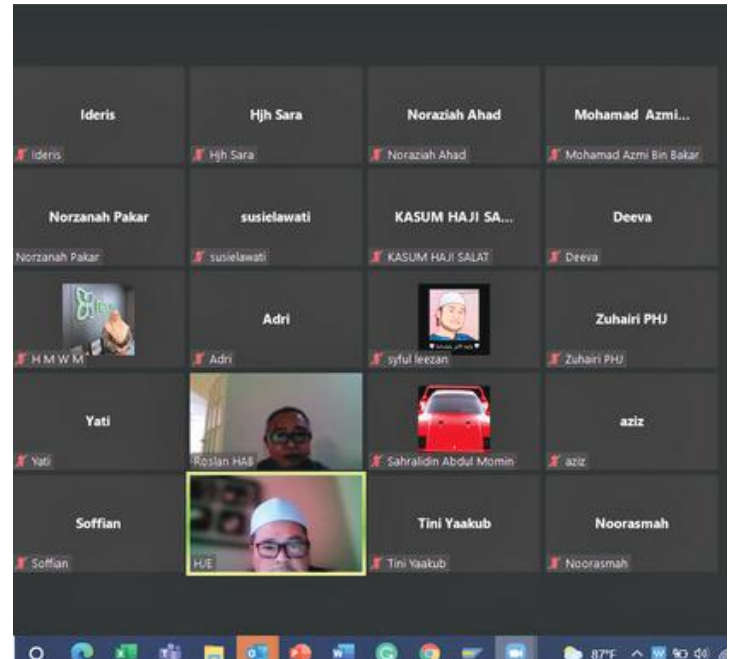
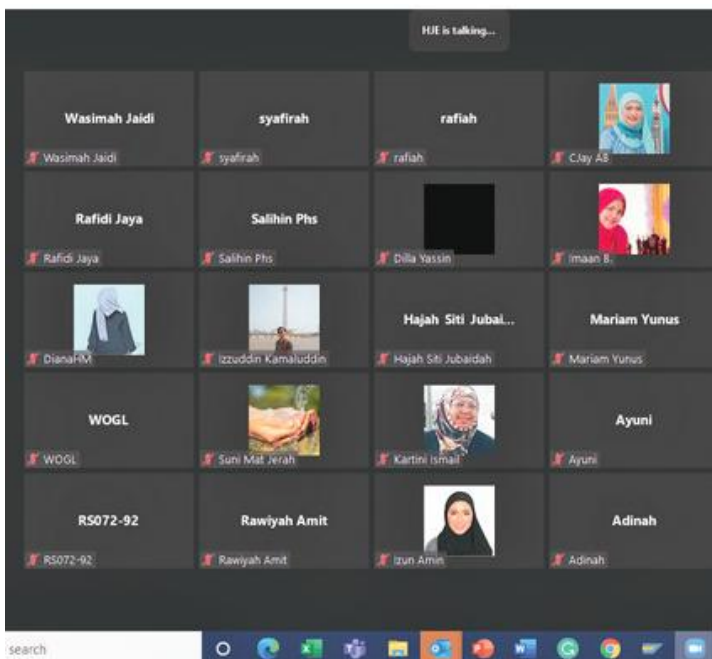

**COVID-19** nex.us **THE DELTA VARIANT**


The first Delta case was identified in December 2020, and the variant soon became the predominant strain of the virus in both India and then Great Britain.



The Delta variant is highly contagious, more than 2x as contagious as previous variants.



Increased transmissibility when compared with other variants, even in some vaccinated individuals.



More data is needed to determine the actual rate of spread and impact of this new variant on disease burden and outcome.
